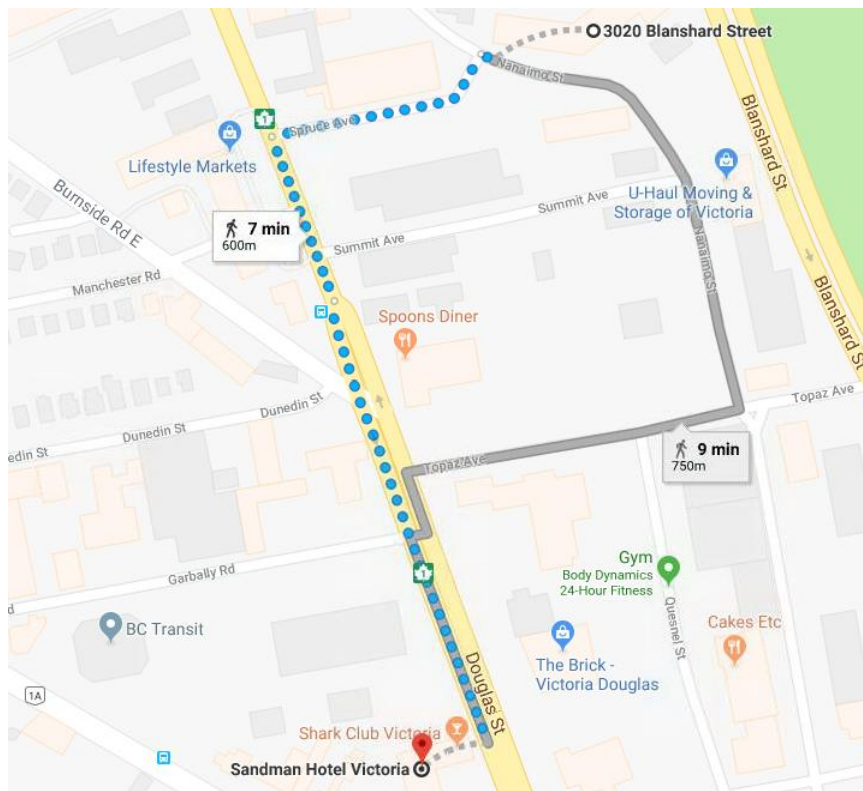

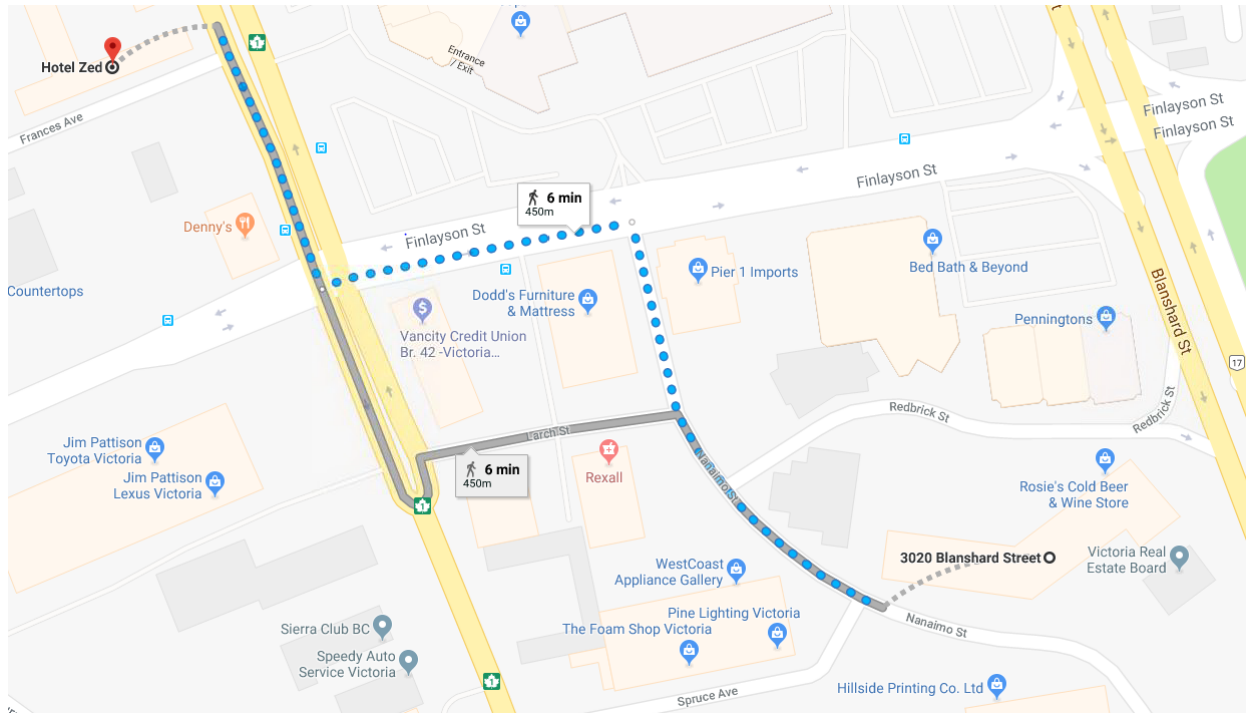

Then: transfer to Route 2 and take bus to Dallas Road at Montreal St; service approximately every 10-15 minutes; or walk approximately 25 minutes from inner harbour
